

Scrap Pile Clean-up Mystery Quilt

Now for the inner border! To make sure the quilt lies flat, measure your quilt through the center to find the length of each border strip. Until next week...!

Supplies

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
rotary cutting mat
sewing machine and thread (we used a medium gray throughout)

1/4-inch seams throughout

Step 19: Cutting

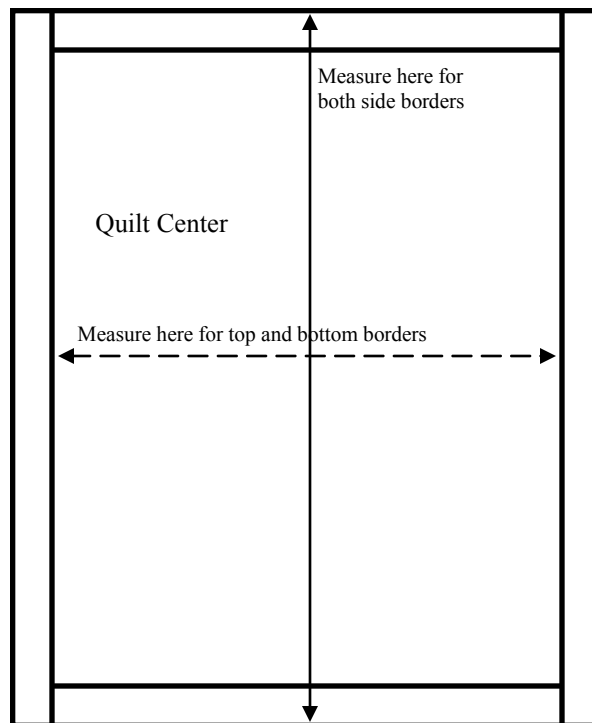
There is no cutting for this step! Next week you will need 1/2 yard for the middle border.

Step 19: Sewing

Piece together **Step 16 Cutting** (2 1/2-inch strips x width of fabric) to border the quilt as shown.

Measure through the middle of quilt, as shown, to find the length needed. Start with the top/bottom borders, then finish with the sides.

press border seams outward



Hint: For the top and bottom borders, we used 1 1/2 strips (width of fabric), and 2 strips (width of fabric) for each side. We diagonally pieced our strips to create the length needed.

We **marked** our strips to the exact measurement needed, sewing then trimming them, just in case we needed a little more in the length.
