

Scrap Pile Clean-up Mystery Quilt

It is your turn to be creative! Pepper your leftover *Prologue units* through the middle border, letting them fall where they may. See you next week!

Supplies

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
rotary cutting mat

1/2 yard fabric for middle border

Left-over 2 1/2-inch square units from *Prologue Step* (you should have 30 units)
sewing machine and thread (we used a medium gray throughout)

1/4-inch seams throughout

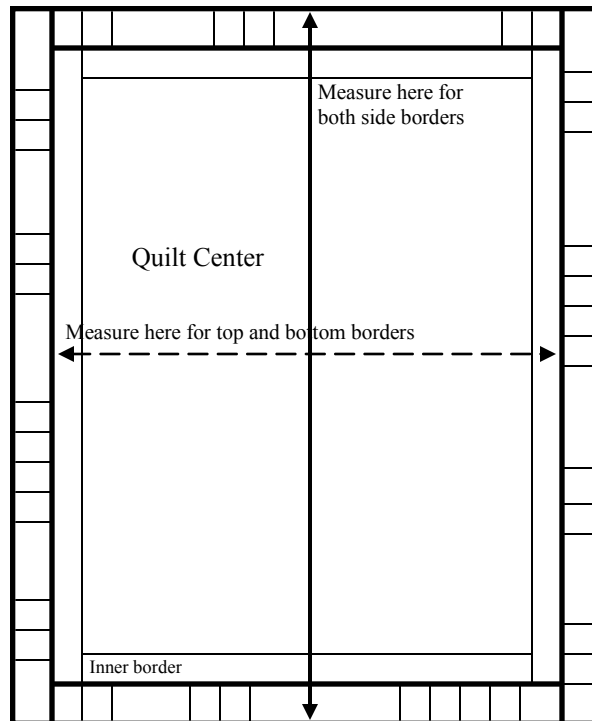
Step 20: Cutting

Cut 5 or 6 strips 2 1/2-inch x width of fabric, as needed. Cut these strips into various size lengths to be sewn in between the remaining *Prologue units*.

Step 20: Sewing

Piece together *Step 20 Cutting* (2 1/2-inch strips) to re-remaining *Prologue units* to complete lengths necessary. Measure through the middle of quilt, as shown, to find the length needed. Start with the top/bottom borders, then finish with the sides.

press border seams outward



*Hint: Piece this border as randomly as you like! Use as many of the **Prologue units** as you want. You may want to cut the strips from the yardage as you go...cutting only what you need to make the length necessary.*

*We **marked** our strips to the exact measurement needed, sewing then trimming them, just in case we needed a little more in the length.*
