

Scrap Pile Clean-up Mystery Quilt

Time to set the outer border! Depending on your scraps and fabric, follow the chart to cut your 6 1/2-inch border strips. See you next week for the final post!



Supplies

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler

rotary cutting mat

fabric for outer border (see chart) *Our quilt has a non-directional, 1 piece border*

sewing machine and thread (we used a medium gray throughout)

1/4-inch seams throughout

Step 21: Cutting

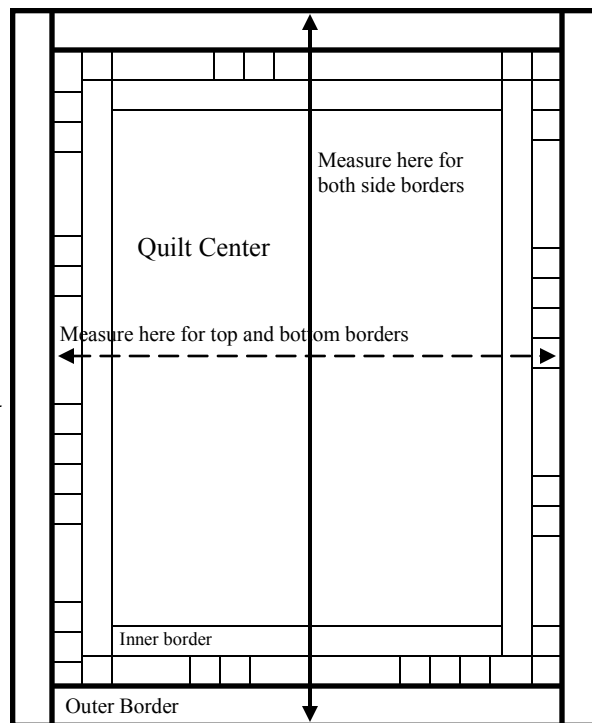
Cut outer border strips using the Border Fabric Chart as a guide

Step 21: Sewing

Measure through the middle of quilt, as shown, to find the length needed. Start with the top/bottom borders, then finish with the sides.

We marked our strips to the exact measurement needed, sewing then trimming them, just in case we needed a little more in the length.

press border seams outward



Border Fabric Chart

1 Piece Border:

3 yards non-directional
Cut 4, 6 1/2-inch strips, trim strips as needed.

Pieced Border:

2 yards non-directional or directional*
Cut 10, 6 1/2-inch strips by width of fabric, piece together as needed.

**Extra fabric may be needed to match design.*
