rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler rotary cutting mat sewing machine and matching thread 10 *Step 1* strips sets 1/2 yard fabric for Inner Border

1/4-inch seams throughout



Cut each *Step 1* strip sets into 5, 8-inch blocks as shown below; each strip set should yield 5 blocks plus a scrap. You will have 50, 8-inch blocks.

From Inner Border fabric cut 6, 2-inch strips wof.

Step 2: Sewing

Sew the Inner Border strips together end-to-end, with diagonal seams, to make one long strip.
