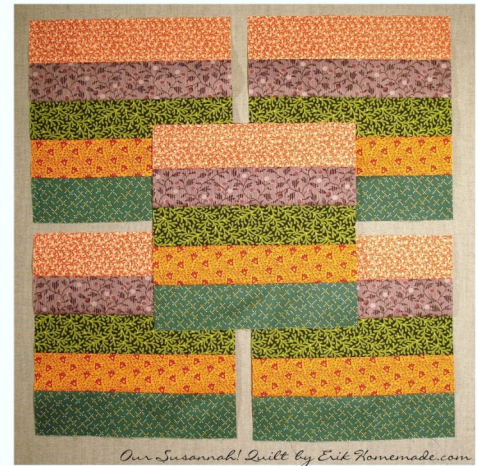


*Our Susannah!*

*Quilt*

This time we cut the blocks for the center of the quilt. For the Inner Border fabric, we chose a contrasting color (bright yellow) that will frame the Rail Fence blocks. Page 3 will post next week!



**Supplies**

- rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
- rotary cutting mat
- sewing machine and matching thread
- 10 **Step 1** strips sets
- 1/2 yard fabric for Inner Border
- 1/4-inch seams throughout

**Step 2: Cutting**

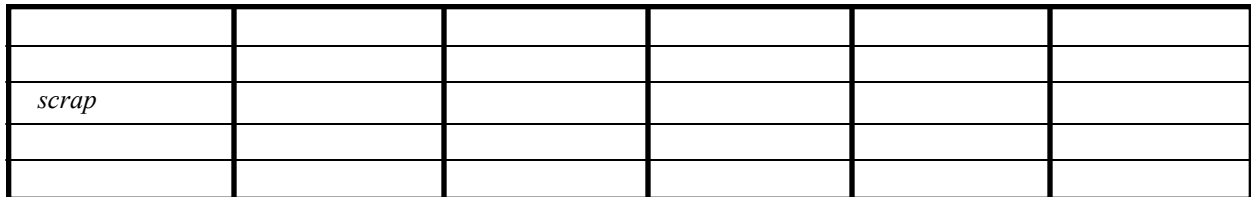
Cut each **Step 1** strip sets into 5, 8-inch blocks as shown below; each strip set should yield 5 blocks plus a scrap. You will have 50, 8-inch blocks.

From Inner Border fabric cut 6, 2-inch strips *wof*.

**Step 2: Sewing**

Sew the Inner Border strips together end-to-end, with diagonal seams, to make one long strip.

*Erik's Tip*

*Cut 50 blocks total*

*!If your strip sets arch a little, re-align them, trim uneven end, and continue cutting following the lines on your cutting mat!*
