

*Our Susannah!*  
*Quilt*



It is time for the top and bottom Outer Borders! Good measurements and six Susannah blocks are all that you need! We are on the home stretch now...only two more weeks left to go! See you next time!

**Supplies**

- rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
- rotary cutting mat
- sewing machine and matching thread
- 6 **Step 4** Susannah blocks

1/4-inch seams throughout

**Step 6: Cutting**

*There is no cutting for this step!*

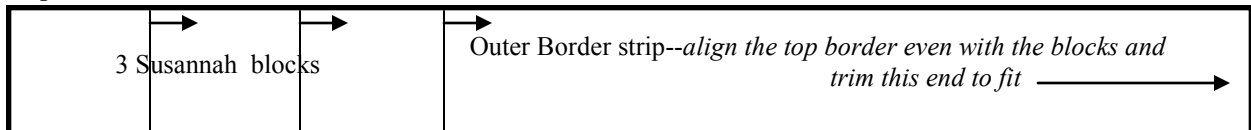
*Erik's Tip*

*Due to the nature of the Susannah blocks, some of my seams didn't "nest". I matched the seams anyway, pinning and matching the seams the best I could. You may need to do likewise; or try turning the block 1/4 turn and see if the seams fall in place.*

**Step 6: Sewing**

Following the diagram below, lay out 3 **Step 4** Susannah blocks for the **top** Outer Border and the **bottom** Outer Border. Sew each set of three blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrows. Sew one **Step 5 Cutting** Outer Border strip to each set of blocks. Measure the quilt through center for the top/bottom Outer Border measurements. Cut each strip to this length (see Erik's Tip from page 7). Sew Outer Border strips to quilt as shown on page 10. You will have 2 **Step 5 Cutting** Outer Border strips to use for the next step. Press seams to the Outer Border (*outwards*).
