Non-Traditional Setting Step 1

begin the center field

This step will begin the finishing Non-Traditional Setting for the quilt. We will offer the finishing steps broken down into sewing steps, much like the blocks, so that those who are working on the quilt as it posts may continue to follow along while continuing to finish their quilt. *There are very few steps in this setting.*



12 1/2 x 94 1/2-inches (row)

Supplies

rotary cutter, 6 x 24-inch ruler, rotary cutting mat
 sewing machine and matching thread
 scraps cut to the sizes below

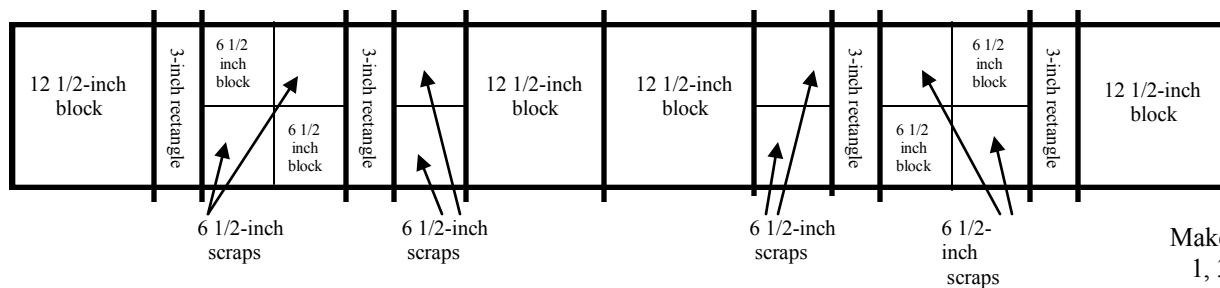
1/4-inch seams throughout; press in the direction that creates the least bulk; press seams as indicated.

Cutting:

- Assorted Scraps: 12 3 x 12 1/2-inch rectangles
- 24 6 1/2-inch squares
- 12 previously made 12 1/2-inch blocks (*any*)
- 12 previously made 6 1/2-inch blocks (*any*)

Constructing rows 1, 3, and 5:

Using the pieces cut above and the previously made blocks, sew together three rows as shown on the diagram below. Use the thick lines to determine the placement of each piece.



Sew the 6 1/2-inch blocks and the 6 1/2-inch scraps together 4-Patch style
