Traditional Setting Step 10

finishes this quilt's assembly

This step will add the side pieced borders of the 'Traditional Setting' quilt and finish the Traditional Setting. This last step is flexible...some may not have made all of the blocks, for one reason or another; this steps allows for a little leeway as desired. The supplies below call for all of the blocks made for the quilt...feel free to omit, substitute, or make repeat blocks as you see fit.



Supplies

- 4 previously made 6 1/2-inch blocks (*remaining*)
- 2 previously made 12 1/2-inch blocks (*remaining*)
- 4 **Step 5** 12 1/2-inch pieced blocks (*remaining*)

rotary cutter and mat
sewing machine and matching thread

Green Floral *remaining fabric strips cut in Step 9*

1/4-inch seams throughout; press seams as indicated.

****A note about these fabrics:**
For the Traditional Setting quilt , we will be showing blocks made in a different colorway than our usual red, white, and blue. These blocks were made to test the pattern...you may find photos of most of these blocks in the 'Ben Franklin Blocks' photo album on the left side of our Main/Home Page. The usual red, white, and blue blocks will be featured in the Non-Traditional Setting posting later.

Constructing the side pieced borders:

Sew two previously made 6 1/2-inch blocks together as shown below. Press in the direction of the arrow. Make 2.
