

Erik's Tips:

Traditional Setting Step 6 begins the assembly of the center field of the Traditional Setting quilt! For this step you will be making rows 1 and 6; the top and bottom rows. Place careful attention on the direction of the **Step 5** units (the *Four patch blocks*) so that your quilt will balance out at the end; the pieced blocks are noted on the row diagram as a guide. We used the same four **Step 5** units for both rows, keeping the other matching set for later in the quilt. Pay as much attention to the direction of the **Step 2** units; the points should all point in the same direction. As for the four previously made 12 1/2-inch blocks...choose any that you like, making sure they are trimmed to tidy 12 1/2-inch square. To ensure a smooth assembly, press your seams as indicated on the row diagram.
