

Turkey Feed Candy Bags

We could not resist making a fun label to finish off our *Turkey Feed Candy* bags! It was easy with double-sided scrapbook cardstock, a computer printed label, and a fancy little button...if you have lots of little ones around, or can not find buttons you like, simply use a rubber stamp or sticker in the center!



For each candy favor you will need

1 plastic candy treat bag
Download our clip-art template (10 per sheet), or design your own labels on the computer
double-sided scrapbook cardstock
1/2-inch ribbon (about 6-inches long)
novelty button
double-stick tape, craft glue, stapler with staples, button shank remover-if needed
scissors, straight-edge, pencil

Download our clip-art template, or design your own on the computer using template for business card (10 per sheet). Print template on desired paper, you will need one label per bag. With straight-edge and pencil mark cardstock a little wider and twice the length (so that card may be folded in half like a package header), cut out. Fold ribbon in half forming a pretty loop in the center. Attach ribbon to back of label with tape. Center label and secure to cardstock with double-sided tape. Fold candy bag down several times to seal. Staple closed. Fold header in half and secure to the top of candy bag with 2 staples (product packaging style).

If button has a shank (a loop to pass the thread through), remove it with shank remover tool. Glue button to label in desired location, allow to dry.
