

Christmas 2010 Mystery Quilt

To help you have a “ball” this holiday season, here is a scrap mystery full of holiday fun! The project will begin posting **11 October 2010!** You will need to raid your scrap basket of red, green, and beige or white fabrics! We can’t tell you too much (because it is a mystery!) but we can say that you will be making a wall-hanging in the spirit of the season! Although the project is wonderfully simply quilted, you can easily embellish it with other goodies due to its three dimensional qualities...each clue will post on Mondays...read each step before you begin.



Supplies (to begin with)

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
rotary cutting mat
sewing machine and matching thread
scraps of red, green, and beige or white, at least 6 7/8-inch square for center of quilt, border fabric will be announced later in the project.

Quilt Information

Block size: not applicable
Number of blocks: not applicable
Finished quilt size: Wall-hanging (*approx. 68 x 68 inches square*)
1/4-inch seams throughout

Prologue: Cutting

Many of you may be anxious to start, so until the first step posts here is some work you can do:
Sort your scraps into reds, greens, and beiges or whites.
From the beige/white scraps cut 12, 6 7/8-inch squares

Prologue: Sewing

There is no sewing for this step!
