

Supplies

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler rotary cutting mat sewing machine and matching thread

1/4-inch seams throughout, unless noted



There is no cutting for this step!

Step 20: Sewing


Sew together 2 *Step 8 Cutting* squares, 2 *Step 17 Sewing* units, 1 *Step 4 Sewing* unit, and 1 *Step 3 Sewing* unit as shown below. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows (you may need to repress some of the seams pressed in an earlier step). You will have 1 red-green and 1 red-beige/white *Step 17 Sewing* units left over to use in the epilogue step, if you like.

Label this row: **O**

In our sample, it didn't matter which way the red stripes went as long as the diagonal line is placed correctly!
