

## *Firework Embellishments*

Add a BANG! to almost any project with a simple-to-make firework explosion! Most items you probably have on hand! Glue an exploding firework to a scrapbook page, refrigerator magnet, picture frame, or anywhere you want to say HAPPY SUMMER!

### *You will need*

tinsel chenille stems, *in desired colors*  
sequins (*we used little flower and petaled shapes*)  
5 mm adhesive backed rhinestone gems  
button for base  
quick-dry craft glue

scissors, toothpicks

*scrapbook page, mirror, picture frame, greeting card, magnet , etc...*

Cut 4 pieces 5 1/2-inches long from tinsel stems. Twist all four pieces together, in the center, to hold together. Referring to photo, carefully spread each stem apart forming an exploding circle. With quick-dry craft glue, adhere tinsel shape to button; allow to dry completely.

Once dry, use quick-dry craft glue to adhere one sequin to cover the end, of each tinsel stem, as shown in the photo. Use a toothpick for exact placement, if needed. Allow sequins to dry.

With a toothpick, pick up one rhinestone and adhere it to the center of a sequin, covering hole. Press in place to secure.

With quick-dry glue, adhere firework embellishment where desired: a scrapbook page, mirror, picture frame, greeting card, etc. Allow to dry.
