

Scrap Pile Clean-up Mystery Quilt

Time for some backing and binding...and of course some quilting! Our project is finished... and our scrap pile...a little bit smaller!

Supplies

quilt batting at least 84 x 106-inches
2 1/3 yard quilt backing fabric (108-inches wide)
3/4 yard (40/42-inch wide) fabric for binding



Step 22:

Layer, baste, and quilt, *as desired*.

Step 22: Cutting

9 2 3/4-inch strips (width of fabric)

Step 22: Sewing

Piece binding strips as needed to go around quilt.

Step 22: Bind the quilt

Fold binding in half, wrong sides together; press. Sew to front of quilt, right sides together, through both thicknesses, and mitering corners. Turn binding to the back of quilt and stitch in place.

We use classic quilting methods for the steps above. By all means use your favorite methods as you like; additional yardages may then be needed.

Do not forget to label, date, and sign your quilt!
