

Scrap Pile Clean-up Mystery Quilt

Here are a few more rectangles to cut and more diagonals to sew! Each diagonally pieced square should measure 6 1/2-inches square when sewn. See you again soon!



Supplies

rotary cutter, 6 x 24-inch ruler
rotary cutting mat
sewing machine and thread (we used a medium gray throughout)
lots and lots of scraps in lots of different sizes
marking pencil or pen

Step 6: Cutting

15 4 1/2 x 6 1/2-inch rectangles from Light scraps

Step 6: Sewing

With a pencil, draw a diagonal line thru all **Step 1** 6 7/8-inch **Light** squares. Layer 1 **Step 1** 6 7/8-inch **Light** square and 1 **Step 4** 6 7/8-inch **Dark** square. Sew 1/4-inch from each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to make 2 6 1/2-inch squares. Repeat for a total of **16** units.
