

*Our Susannah!*  
*Quilt*



Let's add the side borders! Measure through the middle of your quilt like we did last time...you will need the remaining Susannah blocks and the last two border strips. See you next week for Our Susannah! Quilt photo and final thoughts!

**Supplies**

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler  
rotary cutting mat  
sewing machine and matching thread  
10 **Step 4** Susannah blocks

1/4-inch seams throughout

**Step 7: Cutting**

*There is no cutting for this step!*

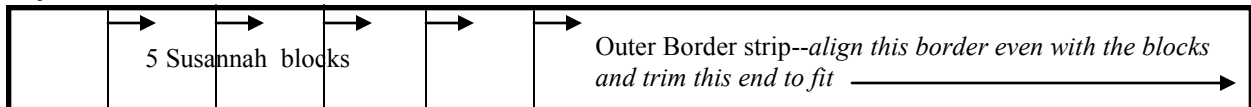
**Step 7: Sewing**

Following the diagrams below, lay out 5 **Step 4** Susannah blocks for the **left** Outer Border and the **right** Outer Border. Sew each set of five blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrows. Sew one remaining **Step 5 Cutting** Outer Border strip to each set of blocks. Measure the quilt through center for both side Outer Border measurements. Cut each strip to this length (see Erik's Tip from page 7). Sew Outer Border strips to quilt as shown on page 12, matching corner blocks. Press seams to the Outer Border (*outwards*).

*Erik's Tip*

*As before, some of my seams didn't "nest". I matched the seams anyway, pinning and matching the seams the best I could. You may need to do likewise; or try turning the block 1/4 turn and see if the seams fall in place.*
