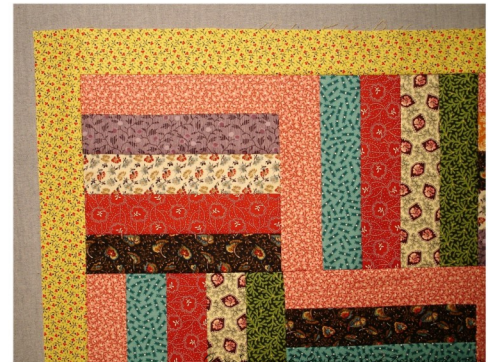


Our Susannah!

Quilt

Now we add the Inner Border! Cut your lengths as you need them from the strips you made in *Step 2*. Follow the diagram on Page 8 to add the borders in order. Same time next week for the next step--have your 16 Susannah blocks ready!



Supplies

rotary cutter and 6 x 24-inch ruler
rotary cutting mat
sewing machine and matching thread
1 yard fabric for Outer Border

1/4-inch seams throughout

Step 5: Cutting

From Outer Border fabric cut 4, 8 1/2-inch strips *wof*.

Step 5: Sewing

Following the diagram on Page 8, measure quilt through center for the top/bottom. Cut the top/bottom Inner border strips; sew in place. From the same diagram, measure through the center of the quilt to find the measurements for the side borders. Cut side borders strips; sew to quilt. Press seams to the Inner Border (*outwards*).

Erik's Tip

When cutting border strips, I like to cut them an inch longer marking the actual measurement on the strip. If I need just a little extra fabric, I have it! Then I trim the strip even with the quilt once it is sewn in place.
